## **Research Analysis**

Introduced HB2312 clarifies that a licensed architect or professional engineer who receives civil immunity for providing architectural, structural, electrical, mechanical or other design professional services may be reimbursed for the cost of producing a report but not for the time or effort involved in producing the report. The measure also removes language that places a time limit on when the voluntary architectural or engineering services must be done in order to receive the immunity. Currently, the immunity is limited to the services rendered during an emergency or within 90 days following the end of an emergency.
