Research Analysis

HB 2328 directs the Department of Public Safety to issue annual vehicle permits to a transportation company or manufacturer of portable buildings for the movement of oversize portable buildings. The measure establishes a 12 foot width, 14 foot height and 45,000 pound limit. The fee for the permit is established as \$500. Requires the Oklahoma Load Limit Map to be made available on the internet and updated every 6 months.

Fiscal Analysis

According to the Department of Public Safety (DPS), there were 218 companies that purchased 5,727 permits in 2012 for the movement of portable buildings at a cost of \$40 each. These permits generated approximately \$229,000 for DPS. The annual permit would only benefit companies that purchase more than 13 permits annually. Even if all 218 companies purchase the annual permit for \$500, it would generate only \$109,000, resulting in a minimum annual revenue loss of \$120,000 to DPS.
