Research Analysis

HB 2351, as introduced, prohibits school districts, administrators, teachers, and other school employees from punishing, humiliating, intimidating, be condescending to, or bullying any student for:

- Brandishing a partially consumed food item that resembles a weapon;
- Possessing a toy weapon that is 5 inches or less;
- Using a hand to simulate a weapon;
- Vocalizing firearm sounds;
- Wearing second amendment right clothing or accessories unless the school has a school uniform policy;
- Drawing, creating, or possessing an image of firearm related material; or
- Using a writing utensil to simulate a weapon.
