Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 2405 modifies the Government Tort Claims Act by modifying tort to include statute and the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma. Also, the measure states that if a court of competent jurisdiction finds tort liability on the part of the state or political subdivision based on a provision of the OK Constitution or state law other than the Governmental Tort Claims Act, the limits of liability provided for in the act will apply. The measure includes an emergency clause.
