Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 2557 creates the Task Force for the Study of County Consolidation in Oklahoma. The task force will consist of nine members: two members appointed by the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives; two members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate; one member appointed by the Governor; the State Auditor and Inspector; the Director and Secretary of Finance, Administration and Information Technology; and the principal house and senate authors of this act. The measure requires that the Task Force meet no later than September 30, 2014. The measure requires that the Task Force produce a final report of its findings and recommendations regarding the consolidation of counties in Oklahoma and be submitted to the Governor, Speaker, and President Pro Tempore no later than February 1, 2015. The measure contains an emergency clause.
