**Research Analysis**

Introduced HB2621 provides a credit for 100 percent of the property tax due on a home where the owner has children that attends private school or is home schooled. The measure would essentially allow a homeowner to pay no property tax to the county treasurer if one or children in the household attends private school or is home schooled.
