**Research Analysis**

HB 2666 modifies the definition of “controlled dangerous substance” to include any drug, substance or immediate precursor listed either temporarily or permanently as a federally controlled substance. Any conflict between state and federal law with regard to the particular schedule in which a substance is listed shall be resolved in favor of state law. The measure adds numerous new scheduled drugs.
