Research Analysis

HB 2684, as introduced, amends several definitions including *abortion inducing drug*, *abortion, drug label*, *Mifeprex regimen*, *mifepristone*, *misoprostol*, and it deletes the term and definition for *federal law*. Additionally, only a physician that has the ability to assess the duration of a pregnancy, diagnose ectopic pregnancies, is able to provide or has plans in place to provide surgical care, and has access to medical facilities equipped to provide blood transfusions and resuscitation may provide an abortion inducing drug, including Mifeprex. Patients receiving Mifeprex must be provided the FDA-approved medication guide and final printed labeling.
