Fiscal Analysis

The PCS for HB2805 creates a new felony for persons who enforce or attempt to enforce any act, law, treaty, order, rule or regulation of the government of the United States regarding a firearm, a firearm accessory, or ammunition that is manufactured commercially or privately and owned in the State of Oklahoma and that remains within the borders of Oklahoma. They penalty is not less than one year imprisonment and/or a fine of \$5,000. Every person convicted and sentenced to the custody of the Department of Corrections costs the state approximately \$49 per day for each day of incarceration. The fiscal impact would be dependent upon the number of adjudicated cases and the length of the prison term imposed.
