Research Analysis

HB 2805 creates the Oklahoma Firearms Sales and Manufacturing Initiative. The measure provides that firearms, firearm accessories or ammunition manufactured and owned in Oklahoma that remains within the borders of Oklahoma is not subject to federal law, treaty, federal regulation or federal executive action, including any federal firearm or ammunition registration program. Prohibits any official, agent or employee of the state, or any dealer selling any firearm in the state from enforcing any law or regulation of the United States regarding any personal firearm, firearm accessory or ammunition that is manufactured and owned in Oklahoma. Creates a new felony for any official, agent or employee of the state, or any dealer selling any firearm in the state to enforce any law or regulation of the United States regarding any personal firearm, firearm accessory or ammunition that is manufactured and owned in Oklahoma.
