**Research Analysis**

HB 2912, as introduced, removes an agency's semiannual requirement to report to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) all reallocation decisions for classified and unclassified positions as well as all adjustments to pay grades or salary assignments for classes in the unclassified service. Likewise, the measure removes the requirement that agencies report the establishment of any new classified and un-classified position that has not been specifically authorized by the legislature. Finally, the measure removes OMES requirement to forward to the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and Speaker of the House a list of those agencies that do not respond by the dates established by OMES.

**Fiscal Analysis**
