Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 2952 authorizes the Cooperative Extension Service at Oklahoma State University to establish examination and accreditation system for county officers, candidates for county office and any other person. The measure authorizes the extension service to establish a registration system and adopt stands for the training, examination and accreditation. Finally, the measure authorizes the extension service to charge fee, maximum of \$100, to any person seeking training and accreditation.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure authorizes the Cooperative Extension Service to establish procedures for examination and accreditation of county officers, candidates for county office and other persons, establish a registration system and standards for the programs and to charge a fee in an amount not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00) to any person seeking training and accreditation from the Service. According to Extension Service officials, current per course fees are set at thirty-five dollars (\$35.00).

Costs to establish and maintain the training, examination and accreditation programs are intended to be offset by the collection of the authorized fee, the revenue amount of which is dependent on participation in the programs.
