Fiscal Analysis

HB3028 would consolidate the Oklahoma Historical Society, Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department and the Oklahoma Arts Council into one agency promptly named the Department of Tourism, History and Cultural Affairs. To the extent that there would be duplication in administrative (and other) processes, those redundancies would be minimized by this consolidation resulting in a positive impact regarding the annual appropriation process.

As HB3028 is currently written, it appears the budgets of all three agencies would be combined in order to perform the duties prescribed herein. That number, based on FY14 budget appropriations would be: \$38,315,636.
