Research Analysis

HB 3399, as introduced, prohibits the state from entering into agreements or contracts which cede state control over educational standards and systems. Additionally, the measure grants school districts an additional year to implement certain standards that align with common core. The measure directs the State Board of Education to evaluate English Language Arts and Mathematic curriculum standards and make any revisions necessary to improve the quality of education for students. The board must submit a report to the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate that outlines the evaluation, comparison results, and list any revisions made to the standards.
