HJR 1003, as introduced, puts to a vote of the people an amendment to the state Constitution that, if approved, would require the Legislature to only consider appropriations and budget measures during odd-numbered years of the legislative session and substantive measures in even-numbered years.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

The resolution sends a constitutional amendment proposal to the people which would modify the legislative process by designating odd-numbered years for consideration of only budget related legislation, with the even-numbered years allotted for consideration of all other legislation, effective for the 55<sup>th</sup> Oklahoma Legislature. Appropriations made in the odd-numbered years will consider expenditures for two (2) fiscal years. The measure also modifies the revenue estimating process to conform to the proposed Legislative structure. The proposal does not modify or eliminate an annual regular Session of the Legislature, therefore no significant costs or savings related to the operations of the Legislature are anticipated.
