Research Analysis

SB 1442 would allow a district attorney who does not seek reelection or has been defeated in a reelection to carry a firearm for personal protection upon completion of an approved course in firearms training. The measure allows CLEET to issue an identification card to a district attorney, assistant district attorneys, former district attorney, U.S. Attorneys, Attorney General or judges and charge a fee of \$100 for the ID card.

Fiscal Analysis

The Committee Substitute for SB1442 allows district attorneys, judges, US Attorneys, the Attorney General and assistant attorney generals to be issued an identification card authorizing them to carry a firearm anywhere in the state after completion of a handgun qualification course for court officials developed by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET). Currently they must complete a firearm training course conducted by a state-certified firearms instructor. The \$100 fee for the identification card will be deposited to the CLEET Peace Officer Revolving Fund.

SB1442 will increase revenue to CLEET depending upon the number of identification cards issued.
