Research Analysis

The CCS to SB 1476 decreases the fees charged for commercial motor vehicle reports furnished by the Department of Public Safety from \$25 to \$15 with \$10 of which to be deposited in the General Revenue Fund and \$5 deposited in the Department of Public Safety Revolving Fund.

Commercial motor vehicle reports furnished by a motor license agent are reduced to \$15 as well, with \$8 paid to the Oklahoma Tax Commission. The Department of Public Safety is directed to establish a procedure to allow motor vehicle reports to be purchased at a bulk rate.

Fiscal Analysis

SB1476 decreases the fees charged for commercial motor vehicle reports from \$25 to \$15. The \$10 decrease is to General Revenue Fund collections. According to the Department of Public Safety, there were 156,524 commercial driver license motor vehicle reports produced in FY-13. With a \$10 fee reduction, deposits to the General Revenue Fund will decrease by approximately \$1,565,240 annually.
