Research Analysis

SB 1845 provides that a court which adjudicated a person mentally incompetent or orders the involuntary commitment of a person due to a mental illness must send a certified copy of the order or adjudication to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for purposes of the National Instant Criminal Background Check system database and to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation. The measure also creates a mechanism to allow a person who has been involuntarily committed or adjudicated to petition the court to remove the disability which prevents the ability of the person to obtain a firearm.
