**Research Analysis**

SB 276 provides that an application for an absentee ballot may be made in person at the county election board office by an agent of the voter who is at least 16 years of age and is not employed by or related to any person whose name appears on the ballot. Prohibits one person from being an agent for more than one voter at any election.
