Research Analysis

Engrossed SB 345 requires tanning facilities to have a knowledgeable operator on location during operating hours and that every patron sign a written statement acknowledging they have read, understand the warnings, and agree to wear protective eyewear. Individuals under the age of eighteen must submit a consent form signed by their parent or legal guardian prior to using a tanning device. The facility must provide the form and the form must be signed in the presence of an employee.

Fiscal Analysis

Engrossed SB 345 requires tanning salons to ensure customers sign a form acknowledging they understand the proper use of tanning beds, and requires persons under the age of 18 receive parental consent prior to using a tanning facility.
