Research Analysis

SB 652 establishes a commercial learner permit for those persons making application for a commercial driver license. The permit is valid for 180 days, which may be renewed one additional time for 180 days. The measure also increases the fees for driver licenses. The bill allows the Department to accept skills test results from another state. Requires the Department to conduct an annual criminal history background check on designated examiners. Allows the Department to revoke driving privileges of a person convicted of fraud related to examination or issuance of a commercial learner permit and for failure to submit to skills reexamination.

Fiscal Analysis

SB652 requires the Department of Public Safety (DPS) to create a new Commercial Driver License Learner Permit to comply with new federal regulations. The cost for software for the new permit is approximately \$60,000.

SB652 also increases the fees for all driver licenses by \$10. The fee increase is estimated to generate an additional \$9,680,260 in revenue for DPS.
