Research Analysis

The CS for SB 667 strikes the title and prohibits the use of electronic benefit transfer cards, which contain public assistance benefits, in liquor stores, casinos, gaming establishments, adult-oriented entertainment establishments or establishments whose principal business is to sell tobacco products. The measure requires DHS to provide the Legislature with status reports on the implementation of the provisions of the bill.
