6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to criminal procedure; prohibiting  
8 non-law-enforcement entities or persons from  
9 participating in roadside traffic stops; providing  
10 for codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1115.6 of Title 22, unless there  
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Under no circumstances may a law enforcement agency or law  
17 enforcement task force authorize or allow a private non-law-  
18 enforcement or nondepartmental entity or person to conduct or  
19 actively participate in a roadside traffic stop or arrest for a  
20 violation of a state traffic law or municipal traffic ordinance.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
