6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Supreme Court;
8 requiring submission of certain orders of the
9 Oklahoma Supreme Court to Legislature; requiring
certain approval in order to become effective;
providing for codification; and providing procedures.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 25 of Title 20, unless there is
15 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Any order of the Oklahoma Supreme Court modifying or repealing
17 any provision of the Code of Judicial Conduct as it exists on the
18 effective date of this act, or enacting a revision to the Code of
19 Judicial Conduct as it exists on the effective date of this act,
20 shall be submitted to the Legislature for its review as and in the
21 manner that agency rules are submitted pursuant to the provisions of
22 the Administrative Procedures Act. Any such order which is not
23 specifically approved by the Legislature in a joint resolution,
24 within thirty (30) legislative days of submission, shall not become

1 effective. Any such joint resolution shall be subject to approval
2 or veto by the Governor as and in the manner as are other bills or
3 joint resolutions.
