12	detonated the explosives packed inside a Ryder truck in front of the
13	Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in downtown Oklahoma City; and
14	WHEREAS, as a result of this heinous act of terrorism, 168
15	innocent lives were lost, including 19 children, and more than 850
16	others were injured; and
17	WHEREAS, the state of Oklahoma was forever changed by these
18	tragic losses; and
19	WHEREAS, in the eighteen years since this act of evil, the state
20	continues to honor the bravery and heroism of first responders and
21	emergency personnel; the perseverance of the injured and bereaved;
22	and the ongoing fight against terrorism and violence; and

8	affected by the bombing of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building on
9	April 19, 1995.

11	City National Memorial and Museum and the National Institute for the
12	Prevention of Terrorism.
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
