PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to insurance; prohibiting health benefit plan from holding certain therapy to a higher standard of clinical evidence for benefit coverage decisions than other therapies; providing for certain construction; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

- SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6060.9b of Title 36, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. A health benefit plan, as defined in subsection C of Section 6060.4 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes, that provides coverage for cancer therapy shall be prohibited from holding proton radiation therapy to a higher standard of clinical evidence for medical policy benefit coverage decisions than the health plan requires for coverage of any other radiation therapy treatment.

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B. Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent a health benefit plan from retaining the ability to offer alternative cost-effective therapy treatments with clinically equivalent outcomes.

C. Nothing in this section shall be construed to mandate the coverage of proton radiation therapy by a health benefit plan.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.

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
