PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or rejection a proposed amendment to Section 4 of Article VII-B of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma; requiring the Judicial Nominating Commission to submit to the Governor the names of all qualified applicants for a vacant judicial office; requiring ranking; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 55TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to Section 4 of Article VII-B of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:

Section 4. When a vacancy in any Judicial Office, however arising, occurs or is certain to occur, the Judicial Nominating Commission shall choose evaluate all qualified applicants and submit

nominees a list of all qualified applicants, each of whom has previously notified the Commission in writing that he or she will serve as a Judicial Officer if appointed. The Commission shall provide to the Governor a ranking based on qualification of all qualified applicants. The Governor shall appoint one (1) of the nominees applicants to fill the vacancy subject to the approval of an Oklahoma Senate Select Panel, but if he or she fails to do so within sixty (60) days the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court shall appoint one (1) of the nominees applicants, the appointment to be certified by the Secretary of State.

SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in the following form:

Legislative Referendum No. \_\_\_\_ State Question No. \_\_\_\_ THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It requires the Judicial Nominating Commission to submit a list and a ranking of all qualified applicants for judicial office to the Governor. The Governor must select a judicial officer from that list of names subject to the approval of an Oklahoma Senate Select Panel. Currently the Commission submits a list of three names and the Governor has to select one of the three.
