12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 4-101, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 4-101. Every person who is a qualified elector as
16	defined by Section 1 of Article III of the Oklahoma Constitution
17	shall be entitled to become a registered voter in the precinct of
18	his <u>or her</u> residence, with the following exceptions <u>conditions</u> :
19	1. Persons convicted of a felony shall be incligible <u>eligible</u>
20	to register for a period of time equal to the time prescribed in the
21	judgment and sentence. to vote when they have fully served their
22	sentence of court mandated calendar days, including any term of
23	incarceration, parole or supervision, or completed a period of
24	probation ordered by any court; and

2. Any person who has been adjudged to be an incapacitated person as such term is defined by Section 1-111 of Title 30 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall be ineligible to register to vote. When such incapacitated person has been adjudged to be no longer incapacitated such person shall be eligible to become a registered voter. The provisions of this paragraph shall not prohibit any person adjudged to be a partially incapacitated person as such term is defined by Section 1-111 of Title 30 of the Oklahoma Statutes from being eligible to register to vote unless the order adjudging the person to be partially incapacitated restricts such persons from being eligible to register to vote.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
