11 An Act relating to roads and bridges; amending
12 Section 4, Chapter 61, O.S.L. 2015 (69 O.S. Supp.
13 2015, Section 1698.215), which relates to memorial
14 highway designations; modifying designation of
15 certain highway; designating the J. Cooper West
16 Memorial Highway; designating the Washita County
17 Undersheriff Brian Beck Memorial Highway; designating
18 the Monte John Tucker Memorial Highway; designating
19 the Meteorologist Gary England Bridge; requiring
20 certain markers; providing for codification;
21 providing an effective date; and declaring an
22 emergency.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 4, Chapter 61, O.S.L. 2015
(69 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 1698.215), is amended to read as
follows:

Section 1698.215. The section of U.S. Highway 81 in Jefferson
County from the junction of U.S. Highway 81 and U.S. Highway 70

1 extending north and then northeast to the municipal limits of
2 Addington shall be designated as the "~~Command Sergeant Major Benny~~
3 Medal of Honor Recipient CSM Bennie G. Adkins Highway". The
4 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
5 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

6 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.231 of Title 69, unless
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 The section of Interstate 40 Business extending west from the
10 Beckham County Line to one-quarter (1/4) of a mile west of the
11 Interstate 40 and State Highway 34 Interchange shall be designated
12 as the "J. Cooper West Memorial Highway". The Department of
13 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
14 name to be placed on the highway.

15 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.232 of Title 69, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The section of Old U.S. Highway 66 in Washita County beginning
19 at the western municipal limits of Canute extending one and one-half
20 (1 1/2) miles west shall be designated as the "Washita County
21 Undersheriff Brian Beck Memorial Highway". The Department of
22 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
23 name to be placed on the highway.

1 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.233 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of State Highway 58 in Alfalfa County beginning one
5 (1) mile east of the intersection of State Highway 58 and State
6 Highway 11 extending east to the eastern municipal limits of Byron,
7 Oklahoma, shall be designated as the "Monte John Tucker Memorial
8 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
9 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

10 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.236 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The bridge over the North Canadian River on U.S. Highway 60
14 north of Seiling, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the
15 "Meteorologist Gary England Bridge". The Department of
16 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
17 on the bridge bearing that name.

18 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.

19 SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
20 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
