COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to memorial highway designations;
designating the John Cooper West Sr. Memorial
Highway; requiring certain markers; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.231 of Title 69, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The section of Interstate 40 Business extending west from the
Beckham County Line to one-quarter (1/4) of a mile west of the
Interstate 40 and State Highway 34 Interchange shall be designated
as the "J. Cooper West Memorial Highway". The Department of
Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
name to be placed on the highway.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.

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
