NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows: 14 15 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Pension 16 Improvement Act". SECTION 2. A new section of law to be codified 17 NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 254 of Title 62, unless there is 18 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 19 20 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the retirement systems of the State of Oklahoma to be designated 21 the "Oklahoma Pension Improvement Revolving Fund". The fund shall 22 be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and 23 shall consist of all monies received and placed in the fund for the 24

1	benefit of retired members and beneficiaries of the retirement
2	systems of the State of Oklahoma from such sources as may be
3	designated by law. Expenditures from the fund shall be made only
4	pursuant to legislative appropriation from the Oklahoma Pension
5	Improvement Revolving Fund to pay for the cost of any legislatively
6	authorized cost-of-living adjustment for the retirees or
7	beneficiaries of the retirement systems of the State of Oklahoma or
8	to reduce the unfunded liabilities of any of the state retirement

10	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.
11	SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
12	of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
13	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
14	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
