BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 13, Chapter 313, O.S.L. 2014 (11 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section 56-103), is amended to read as follows:

Section 56-103. A. The Municipal Campaign Finance and Financial Disclosure Act shall apply only to municipalities with a population of more than ten thousand (10,000) according to the most recent Federal Decennial Census and a general fund expenditure budget in excess of Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) in the fiscal year in which the municipal elections are held.

B. A municipality described in subsection A of this section may enact a comprehensive code of campaign finance and personal financial disclosure ordinances, including provisions for enforcement thereof, in which case the Municipal Campaign Finance and Financial Disclosure Act shall not apply to the municipality.

1	Any municipality enacting such a code shall file a notice of its
2	action with the Ethics Commission, which shall have no enforcement
3	responsibilities under the code.
4	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5	of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
6	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
