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An Act relating to the Oklahoma Medicaid Program; directing Oklahoma Health Care Authority to initiate certain procedures for certain purposes; directing Authority to seek certain approval; directing promulgation of rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5028 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

- A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall initiate requests for proposals for care coordination models for dual- and nondual-eligible noninstitutionalized aged, blind and disabled persons. The Authority shall seek any federal approval necessary to implement the provisions of this act.
- B. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this act.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
