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7 An Act relating to poor persons; requiring Oklahoma  
8 Health Care Authority to promulgate certain rules;  
9 requiring Oklahoma Department of Human Services to  
10 eliminate Medicaid eligibility for certain  
11 individuals; requiring Authority to seek certain  
12 federal approval; providing for codification; and  
13 providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1011.12 of Title 56, unless  
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall promulgate rules  
19 that eliminates benefits for any nonpregnant able-bodied adult under  
20 sixty-five (65) years of age.

21 B. The Oklahoma Department of Human Services shall eliminate  
22 Medicaid eligibility for any nonpregnant able-bodied adult under  
23 sixty-five (65) years of age.

24 C. The Authority shall seek any federal approval necessary to  
implement the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
