An Act relating to the Oklahoma Medicaid Program;
directing Oklahoma Health Care Authority to initiate
certain procedures for certain purposes; requiring
care coordination models to be phased in over certain
time period; directing promulgation of rules;
providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

SUBJECT: Oklahoma Medicaid Program

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5028 of Title 63, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall initiate requests
for proposals for care coordination models for aged, blind and
disabled persons. Care coordination models for members receiving
institutional care shall be phased in two (2) years after the
initial enrollment period of a care coordination program.

B. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board shall promulgate
rules to implement the provisions of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
