1 "SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2011, Section 50014, as
2 amended by Section 570, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (68 O.S. Supp.
3 2014, Section 50014), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 50014. A. 1. There is hereby created in the State
5 Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
6 Department, to be designated the "Oklahoma Tourism Promotion
7 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject
8 to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received
9 by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department and apportioned to
10 such fund pursuant to the provisions of Sections 1353 and 1403 of
11 this title and such other monies accredited to the fund pursuant to
12 law.

13 2. ~~All~~ Except for monies transferred as provided for in
14 paragraphs 3 and 4 of this subsection, all monies accruing to the
15 credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and
16 expended by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department for the
17 purpose of Oklahoma tourism promotion, as defined by Section 50011
18 of this title, provided that the Department shall ensure that all
19 areas of the state will be adequately promoted, and all monies
20 expended from the fund shall reflect a consistent brand and image in
21 the promotion of Oklahoma tourism.

22 3. ~~No monies~~ The Department shall annually transfer an amount
23 equal to two-tenths of one percent (0.2%) of the total amount
24 accruing to the credit of the fund each fiscal year to the Wildlife

1 Conservation Fund created in Section 3-302 of Title 29 of the
2 Oklahoma Statutes.

3 4. Monies from this revolving fund ~~shall~~ may be transferred for
4 any the purpose ~~to any other state agency or be used for the purpose~~
5 ~~of contracting with any other state agency or reimbursing any other~~
6 ~~state agency for any expense with the exception of contracting and~~
7 payment for research work completed by an institution of The
8 Oklahoma State System of Higher Education. ~~No monies from this~~
9 ~~revolving fund shall be expended for any wage or salary of any~~
10 ~~employee of any state agency.~~

11 5. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants
12 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
13 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
14 Services for approval and payment.

15 B. 1. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
16 revolving fund for the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department,
17 to be designated the "Oklahoma Tourism Capital Improvement Revolving
18 Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal
19 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the
20 Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department and apportioned to such
21 fund pursuant to the provisions of Sections 1353 and 1403 of this
22 title and such other monies accredited to the fund pursuant to law.

23 2. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
24 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma

1 Tourism and Recreation Department for the purpose of funding capital
2 improvement projects or operations at state parks and tourist
3 information centers; provided, no more than twenty percent (20%) of
4 the amount accruing annually shall be expended for the purpose of
5 funding operations.

6 3. No monies from this revolving fund shall be transferred for
7 any purpose to any other state agency. Expenditures from the fund
8 shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against
9 claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of
10 Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment."
