I move to amend HB1805

On page 2, lines 7-10, by deleting the current subsection B and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection B:

"B. 1. The candidate for Governor for each recognized political party shall designate the person who shall run as the nominee for Lieutenant Governor for the party. The nominee shall be of the same political party as the candidate for Governor. The designation shall be filed with the Secretary of the State Election Board any time prior to seventy-two (72) hours after the State Election Board certifies the list of nominees for office following the Primary Election, unless a Runoff Primary Election is necessary. If a Runoff Primary is necessary, the designation shall be filed with the Secretary of the State Election Board any time prior to seventy-two (72) hours after the State Election Board certifies the list of nominees for office following the Runoff Primary Election. The designation shall include the information required by Section 5-111 of this title for Declarations of Candidacy. If the candidate for Governor fails to file the designation of nomination within the required time, the governing authority of the political party shall appoint the nominee for Lieutenant Governor by within an additional seventy-two (72) hours.

2. If a candidate for Governor is an independent candidate, the candidate shall designate a person to who shall run for Lieutenant Governor as the gubernatorial candidate's running-mate. The designation shall be made after the State Election Board certifies the list of nominees for office of each recognized political party. If there is no Runoff Primary Election, the designation shall be made any time prior to seventy-two (72) hours after the Primary Election. If there is a Runoff Primary Election for any recognized political party, the independent candidate shall make the designation at any time prior to seventy-two (72) hours after the Primary Election or any time prior to seventy-two (72) hours after the Runoff Primary Election, whichever the candidate selects. shall include the information required by Section 5-111 of this title for Declarations of Candidacy. If the candidate for Governor fails to file the designation of nomination within the required time, the candidate's name shall not appear on the General Election ballot.

By deleting Section 2 from the bill and renumbering subsequent sections;

And on page 5, line 7, by deleting the words "nominated and" after the words "shall be" and before the word "elected" and by adding after the words "elected jointly" and before the word "by" the words "at the General Election"
