On page 6, line 16, by deleting the word "majority" before the words "of the Senate" and adding in lieu thereof the words "select committee";

And on page 6, line 16, after the word "and" and before the word "certified" by adding the following language:

"House of Representatives. Senate members of the select committee shall be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and House of Representative members of the select committee shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. Until changed by statute, the select committee shall consist of ten (10) legislators, with five (5) members appointed from each house of the Legislature, and shall include at least one member from each house of the Legislature who is not a member of the political party holding the majority of seats in that house. The appointment and confirmation shall be"

1 "Section 1. (a) The provisions of this Article shall govern  
2 the selection and tenure of all Justices of the Supreme Court and  
3 Judges of the Court of Criminal Appeals of the State of Oklahoma, to  
4 which the provisions hereof may be extended as hereinafter provided,  
5 other provisions of the Constitution or statutes of the State of  
6 Oklahoma to the contrary notwithstanding, and the provisions of  
7 Article VII as proposed by House Joint Resolution No. 508 of the  
8 First Session of the Thirty-first Oklahoma Legislature to the  
9 contrary notwithstanding.

10 (b) As used in this ~~Section~~ Article, "Judicial Office" means  
11 the offices of Justice of the Supreme Court and Judges of the Court  
12 of Criminal Appeals and "Judicial Officer" means a Justice or Judge  
13 of each such court, excluding retired or supernumerary Justices or  
14 Judges."
