- 1 A. The State Department of Education, in collaboration with
- 2 the State Department of Health, may establish an instructional
- 3 program for students consistent with the provisions of this
- 4 section. The content of instruction that is used by local schools
- 5 shall be at the discretion of the appropriate school board;
- 6 provided, the instructional program shall:
- 7 1. Provide accurate, scientifically verifiable information
- 8 concerning the probable anatomical and physiological
- 9 characteristics of the unborn child at two-week gestational
- 10 intervals. The State Department of Education may utilize as a
- 11 resource the material dealing with "Characteristics of the Unborn
- 12 Child" created pursuant to Section 1-738.2 of Title 63 of the

- 4. Comply with the provisions of the Parents' Bill of Rights,
