BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

A new section of law not to be

of long-term water projects within the boundaries of this state, there is hereby created the Oklahoma Water Use Working Group. Oklahoma Water Use Working Group will adopt an "all-of-the-above" approach as it considers water projects that can help alleviate

current and long-term shortages including, but not limited to:

- 1. Interbasin transfers of water;
- 2. Heightened water conservation, efficiency, reuse, and recycling measures;
- 3. Voluntary consolidation of existing infrastructure and water supplies;
- 4. Maximizing existing reservoirs and construction of new reservoirs;
- 5. Increasing water storage and minimizing transportation and evaporative losses of water used for agricultural purposes; and
  - 6. Managing or augmenting aquifer storage and recovery.
- B. The Oklahoma Water Use Working Group shall consist of eleven (11) members as follows:
  - 1. Secretary of Energy and Environment;
  - 2. Secretary of Agriculture;

- 3. Secretary of Commerce and Tourism;
- 4. Executive Director of the Oklahoma Water Resources Board;
- 5. Representative of the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes;
  - 6. Representative of the Oklahoma Municipal League;
  - 7. Representative of the Oklahoma Rural Water Association;
- 8. Two at-large members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, one to represent the southwest quadrant and one to represent southeast quadrant of the state; and

9. Two at-large members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, one to represent the northwest quadrant and one to represent northeast quadrant of the state.

- C. The working group shall consider the current and future water requirements of all the citizens of this state, and the various industries operating in this state which depend on water resources.
- D. Meetings, activities, and reports of the working group shall be subject to the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act and the Oklahoma Open Records Act. All actions of the working group shall be approved by a majority vote of the membership.
- E. Members shall be designated or appointed no later than July 1, 2015. The Governor shall call the first meeting of the working group. The working group shall elect from among its membership a chair who shall be responsible for calling meetings. Vacancies shall be filled by the original appointing authority, and members shall serve at the pleasure of their appointing authority. Members of the working group shall serve without compensation but may be eligible for actual and necessary travel reimbursement by their appointing authority pursuant to the State Travel Reimbursement Act.
- F. Staffing requirements of the working group may be provided as needed by the Governor's office, the Oklahoma State Senate, the House of Representatives, the Oklahoma Water Resources Board or any

other governmental agency or entity as directed by the working group.

- G. Any reports or recommendations approved by the working group shall be presented to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives and be made publicly available.
- H. Activities of the working group shall terminate no later than December 1, 2016, unless otherwise extended by the Legislature.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
