9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to payroll deductions; criminalizing
11 certain payroll deductions by state agencies;
12 defining terms; providing for codification; and
13 providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.70.1 of Title 62, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. It shall be unlawful for any state agency to make payroll
20 deductions on behalf of a state employee for membership dues in any
21 public employee association or organization or professional
22 organization that collectively bargains on behalf of its membership
23 pursuant to any provision of federal law.

24 B. For purposes of this section:

1 1. "State agency" means any office, officer, bureau, board,
2 counsel, court, commission, institution, unit, division, body or
3 house of the executive or judicial branches of the state government,
4 whether elected or appointed, excluding political subdivisions of
5 the state. State agency shall include public school districts, the
6 Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, the institutions,
7 centers, or other constituent agencies of The Oklahoma State System
8 of Higher Education, the State Board of Career and Technology
9 Education, technology center school districts, the State
10 Legislature, and the office of the Governor; and

11 2. "Public employee" means an elected or appointed officer or
12 employee or contract employee of a state agency as defined in this
13 section, unless otherwise indicated.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
