9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to poor persons; requiring Oklahoma
11 Health Care Authority to promulgate certain rules;
12 requiring Oklahoma Department of Human Services to
13 eliminate Medicaid eligibility for certain
 individuals; requiring Authority to seek certain
 federal approval; providing for codification; and
 providing an effective date.

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16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1011.12 of Title 56, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall promulgate rules
21 that eliminates benefits for any nonpregnant able-bodied adult under
22 sixty-five (65) years of age.

1 B. The Oklahoma Department of Human Services shall eliminate
2 Medicaid eligibility for any nonpregnant able-bodied adult under
3 sixty-five (65) years of age.

4 C. The Authority shall seek any federal approval necessary to
5 implement the provisions of this section.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
