## AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to agriculture; amending 2 O.S. 2011, Section 7-414, which relates to the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act; allowing for certain incidental sales and advertising of raw milk; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2011, Section 7-414, is

amended to read as follows:

Section 7-414. A. The provisions of the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act shall not be construed to:

- 1. Include incidental sales of raw milk directly to consumers at the farm where the milk is produced;
- 2. Include incidental sales of raw milk delivered by the farm producer of milk directly to the final consumer's residence from the farm where the milk is produced; provided any unpasteurized milk shall be clearly labeled by the producer as "unpasteurized raw milk";

3. Include incidental sales of raw milk by the farm producer
sold directly to the consumer at a farmers' market as defined by the
Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry; provided any
unpasteurized milk shall be clearly labeled by the producer as
<pre>"unpasteurized raw milk";</pre>
4. Preclude the advertising of the incidental sales of raw
milk;
$5.$ Preclude the advertising of the incidental $\frac{\text{sale}}{\text{sales}}$ of
goat milk; and

- 3.6. Prohibit any farmer or producer from making cheese using milk or cream produced on the farm of such farmer or producer.
- B. For purposes of this section, incidental sales of goat milk are those sales where the average monthly number of gallons sold does not exceed one hundred (100).
  - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
