1 1 An Act relating to state officers; amending 74 O.S.
1 2 2011, Section 250.4, as amended by Section 3 of
1 3 Enrolled House Joint Resolution No. 1096 of the 2nd
1 4 Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature (74 O.S.
1 5 Supp. 2014, Section 250.4), which relates to
1 6 statewide elected officers; modifying salaries; and
1 7 providing an effective date.

1 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 9 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 250.4, as
2 0 amended by Section 3 of Enrolled House Joint Resolution No. 1096 of
2 1 the 2nd Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature (74 O.S. Supp.
2 2 2014, Section 250.4), is amended to read as follows:

2 3 Section 250.4 Pursuant to provisions of the Constitution of the
2 4 State of Oklahoma from and after the beginning date of a term of
 office which commences in, or after, January 1999 January of 2016,

1 the following officers of the State of Oklahoma shall be annually
2 compensated for their services, payable monthly, as follows:

3 1. The Governor shall receive a salary ~~equal to the salary~~
4 ~~received by the Chief Justice of the Oklahoma Supreme Court;~~
5 ~~provided however, the Governor shall not receive any increase in~~
6 ~~salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution~~
7 ~~of One Hundred Forty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$147,000.00);~~

8 2. The Lieutenant Governor shall receive a salary ~~equal to the~~
9 ~~salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a~~
10 ~~population greater than ten thousand (10,000) and less than thirty~~
11 ~~thousand (30,000); provided however, the Lieutenant Governor shall~~
12 ~~not receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of~~
13 ~~Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven~~
14 ~~Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);~~

15 3. The Attorney General shall receive a salary ~~equal to the~~
16 ~~salary received by the Presiding Judge of the Court of Civil~~
17 ~~Appeals; provided however, the Attorney General shall not receive~~
18 ~~any increase in salary as a result of Section 1 of this resolution~~
19 ~~of One Hundred Thirty-two Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-five Dollars~~
20 ~~(\$132,825.00);~~

21 4. The State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall receive
22 ~~a salary equal to the salary received by a district judge; provided~~
23 ~~however, the State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall not~~
24 ~~receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of~~

Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred Twenty-four Thousand

Three Hundred Seventy-three Dollars (\$124,373.00);

5. Each member of the Corporation Commission shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000); provided however, the Commissioners shall not receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);

6. The State Treasurer shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000); provided however, the State Treasurer shall not receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);

7. The State Auditor and Inspector shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000); provided however, the State Auditor and Inspector shall not receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);

8. The State Insurance Commissioner shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a

1 county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000); provided
2 however, the State Insurance Commissioner shall not receive any
3 increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of
4 this resolution of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred
5 Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00); and

6 9. The Commissioner of Labor shall receive a salary equal to
7 the salary received by a special judge; provided however, the
8 Commissioner of Labor shall not receive any increase in salary as a
9 result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution of One
10 Hundred Five Thousand Fifty-three Dollars (\$105,053.00).

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective in accordance with
2 the provisions of Section 58 of Article V of the Oklahoma
3 Constitution.
