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10       An Act relating to the Office of Management and  
11       Enterprise Services; amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section  
12       78a, as amended by Section 729, Chapter 304, O.S.L.  
13       2012 (74 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 78a), which relates  
14       to the requisition of motor vehicles; adding  
15       exemption; requiring certain report; authorizing  
16       Department to sunset program; providing an effective  
17       date; and declaring an emergency.

18   BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19       SECTION 1.       AMENDATORY       74 O.S. 2011, Section 78a, as  
20       amended by Section 729, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (74 O.S. Supp.  
21       2015, Section 78a), is amended to read as follows:

22       Section 78a. A. State agencies with authority to own motor  
23       vehicles shall submit a requisition to the Director of the Office of  
24       Management and Enterprise Services prior to acquisition of a motor  
25       vehicle. The requisition shall state the type of vehicle, the  
26       intended purpose of the vehicle, a statement that the agency has

1 actual need for the vehicle, the supplier of the vehicle, that the  
2 state agency has sufficient funds to acquire and maintain the  
3 vehicle and cite the statutory authority of the state agency to  
4 acquire a vehicle.

5 B. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise  
6 Services shall review the requisition and approve or deny the  
7 request of the state agency within fifteen (15) days of receipt.

8 C. The provisions of subsections A and B of this section shall  
9 not apply to the Department of Public Safety ~~or~~ , the Oklahoma State  
10 Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control or the Oklahoma  
11 Military Department.

12 D. The provisions of subsections A and B of this section shall  
13 not apply to CompSource Oklahoma if CompSource Oklahoma is operating  
14 pursuant to a pilot program authorized by Sections 3316 and 3317 of  
15 this title.

16 E. The Oklahoma Military Department shall annually report to  
17 the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of  
18 Representatives and the Secretary of Finance the amount of savings  
19 realized from its authority to purchase motor vehicles. If such  
20 report is not filed or does not document such savings, the authority  
21 of the Department to purchase motor vehicles shall cease to be in  
22 effect on January 1, 2022.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.  
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1       SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
