L 6	A. There is hereby established the "Oklahoma State Government
L7	Open Records One-Stop Initiative".
18	B. The Chief Information Officer shall develop and maintain an
L 9	online web presence at the web address OpenRecords.ok.gov. The site
20	shall allow the public to file a request for documents pursuant to
21	the terms of the Oklahoma Open Records Act.
22	C. Upon finding that requested documents are open records under
23	the provisions of the Oklahoma Open Records Act, the Chief

Information Officer shall retrieve and deliver the documents to the

3	D. Documents requested through the open records web portal
4	shall be delivered to the requester in electronic format.
5	E. Immediately following delivery of the documents requested to

9	obligation of public officials to comply with already existing
10	provisions of the Oklahoma Open Records Act.
