18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
19 2ND SESSION OF THE 55TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

20 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
21 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
22 the repeal of Section 5 of Article II of the Constitution of the
23 State of Oklahoma which relates to use of public monies or property
24 for sectarian or religious purposes.

1 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
2 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
3 the following form:

6 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

7 This measure repeals Section 5 of Article 2 of the Oklahoma
8 Constitution. This section prohibits the use of public
9 monies or property for sectarian or religious purposes.
