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1 Improvement Plan. It shall be presented to the Oklahoma Legislature
2 along with a summary of comments received from public hearings and
3 shall include the identification of specific provisions of the
4 Affordable Care Act to be waived in the State of Oklahoma.

5 D. Participating agencies, including but not limited to the
6 State Department of Health, the Oklahoma Health Care Authority, the
7 Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services and the
8 Insurance Department, shall develop the State Innovation Waiver and
9 submit any and all necessary information for approval to all
10 relevant entities.

11 E. The Insurance Department is hereby authorized to conduct
12 rate review for the individual and small group health insurance
13 market upon implementation of the State Innovation Waiver under
14 Section 1332.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
