BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 35.2 of Title 12, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

In any case or proceeding in the district courts, the court clerk at the time of the filing of a motion shall set the date and time for a hearing on such motion, if requested, and sign any order setting the hearing, prepared by the moving party, on behalf of the judge. Such order shall contain a properly executed certificate of service. The district court judge may reschedule the date and time set by the court clerk, and provide notice of the new date and time to all parties.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
