SENATE BILL 299

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to larceny of livestock or implements of husbandry; amending 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1716, which relates to theft of domestic animals or implements of husbandry; increasing punishment; increasing fine; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1716, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1716. Any person in this state who shall steal any horse, jackass, jennet, mule, cow, hog, or implement of husbandry, as defined in Section 1-125 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be guilty of a felony and upon conviction shall be punished by confinement in the State Penitentiary for a term of not less than ~~three (3)~~ five (5) years, nor more than ~~ten (10)~~ fifteen (15) years; and any person in this state who shall steal any dog, sheep, or goat, shall be guilty of a felony and upon conviction therefor shall be punished by confinement in the State Penitentiary for a term not less than six (6) months, nor more than three (3) years, ~~or~~ and by a

1 fine in an amount that is equal to three times the value of animals  
2 and machinery that were stolen but not more than ~~Five Hundred~~  
3 ~~Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00), or by both such fine and~~  
4 ~~imprisonment~~ Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00).

5 The word "horse" as used in this section includes all animals of the  
6 equine species and the word "cow" includes all animals of bovine  
7 species.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
